Introductory note

This Guide presents sights and attractions, services, and facilities that you will find in the city of Kavala with detailed information on their friendliness and accessibility for the various categories of disability. This information, which was methodically collected by field autopsies, is addressed to everyone, whether they are visiting Kavala for the first time or living here.

These autopsies, which were carried out by specially trained inspectors in collaboration with representatives of the local disability movement, were not intended to certify the accessibility of the inspected infrastructure in accordance with relevant accessibility standards and guidelines. Knowing the diversity of the needs of people with disabilities, the purpose of the inspections was to methodically record the existing access conditions, with reference to specific measurements where deemed necessary, so that each interested party / reader has at his disposal the necessary information that will allow him to assess for himself whether or not the proposed options are appropriate for his personal service and safety.

We hope this Guide will attract and facilitate each of you individually to visit and enjoy Kavala without obstacles. Get to know its unique traditions, local products, customs and traditions, cultural interests and the incomparable natural beauty of the area and love it as it deserves it.

It is pointed out that this guide was implemented in the framework of the [Sustainable Urban Development Strategy of the Municipality of Kavala](#) and therefore focuses mainly on the Strategy Intervention Area, i.e. the districts of Agios Ioannis, center, Agios Nikolaos and Panagia, most of the districts of Agios Pavlos and Georgiou and a small part of the "Sougiolou" district. However, the connection of the Intervention Area with important areas of the municipality, such as the archaeological site of Philippi and the baptistry of Lydia, is particularly important.

What are QR codes in the Guide?

As you can see, the Guide makes extensive use of Quick Response Codes (QRs), which act as barcodes that can be scanned with your device's camera for quick access to web addresses without having to type or remember the address.

So, for example, scanning the QR code next to the description of a museum, and if your device has Internet access (e.g., is connected to Wi-Fi or uses mobile Internet data), it will automatically open a page (on the website www.accesskavala.gr) with additional information from this in the Guide, such as location on the map, additional photos, detailed accessibility reports, completed inspection sheets, etc.



Our suggestion for easy use of the Guide

For easy and practical use of the Guide it is recommended:

Either you have the Guide in printed form with you and you can scan the codes with your device whenever you need (e.g., on the street, at the cafe, etc.).

Either open the file directly on your device and use the coded as simple links, without having to scan them (e.g., simply by clicking on PDF or with Ctrl + click on Word).

How to scan QR codes

For iPhone. Open the integrated camera application and then turn the camera at the QR code (as if you wanted to photograph it). At the top of the screen there will be a notification that will show you the source of the page and if you select it, you will be automatically redirected to the page.

For Android. Open the integrated camera application (in which you must have enabled the Bixby Vision) and then focus on the QR code (as if you wanted to photograph it). As soon as the camera "sees" the code, the relevant page will automatically open.

In addition, in the Google Play Store (Android) and in the App Store (iPhone) you will find many applications.

Tips: Make sure the code is adequately lit. When scanning, hold the phone firmly and find the correct distance so that the application viewfinder focuses correctly on the code. Make sure the entire code is displayed in the viewfinder.

Guide dogs for blinds and assistance dogs for people with disabilities

According to Greek law (Laws 3868/2010, 4235/2014 and 4238/2014), access is allowed for guide dogs and assistance dogs for people with disabilities everywhere. However, these dogs must be certified as such.

The Guide refers to companies that, unaware of the law, have stated that they do not accept guide dogs or assistance dogs, so that prospective visitors are fully informed of the attitude they may encounter.

Terminology

Accessible WC: Specially designed WC intended for the service of people with disabilities and especially people with wheelchairs.

Accessible room: Specially designed room or temporary residence intended for the accommodation of people with disabilities and especially people with wheelchairs.

Special parking spaces for the people with disabilities: Special spaces marked with appropriate markings and intended exclusively for the use of vehicles of persons with disabilities.

Accessible space: Space accessible to wheelchair users. Where there are predictions for the visually impaired or hearing impaired, they are explicitly mentioned.

Accessible swimming pool / beach: When it is stated that the swimming pool of an accommodation or a beach / coast is accessible, it is understood that there is wheelchair access to the surrounding areas. It is not understood that there is a specific provision for wheelchair users to enter the water unless this is explicitly indicated.

Accessible lift: The elevators found to have a satisfactory door opening (automatic and over 82 cm), satisfactory dimensions of free space both in front and inside the cabin, control panel at a suitable height for people in wheelchairs, and other specifications for visually impaired and hearing impaired (embossed buttons, visual and / or audible floor announcements, etc.).

A few words about Kavala

Kavala is a seaside city, built amphitheatrically at the foot of Mount Symbol, in Eastern Macedonia, between Thessaloniki and Alexandroupolis.

The city was founded by Thassian settlers in the 7th century B.C. and originally had the name "Neapolis". It was a member of the Second Athenian Alliance until its conquest by King Philip of Macedonia, who founded Philippi (modern-day Krinides) which was the first capital of Macedonia. In 54 A.D. Apostle Paul landed in Naples and founded in Philippi the first Christian Church in Europe. In the Byzantine years, it was renamed Christoupolis, while in 1380 and after the Ottoman Conquest, it took the name Kavala that it bears to this day.

At the beginning of the 19th century, tobacco growing began in Kavala, being an integral part of the history of the city for over 150 years, as well as the reason why the city is rich and prosperous. Since 1918, about 50 tobacco factories have been operating in Kavala, while the 160 tobacco warehouses employed half of the country's tobacco workers (approximately 14,000). However, the global financial crisis that erupted in 1929, the fact that the profession became less "protected" and the withdrawal of many men from the tobacco industry led the largest tobacco center in the Balkans to a sharp decline.

Nowadays, it is the seat of the municipality of Kavala and the capital of the Regional Unit of Kavala. It has one of the largest passenger ports (Apostolle Pavlos) in Greece and one of the most important commercial ports in the country and the Mediterranean (Commercial Port PHILLIPOS II). It also has one of the largest fish ladders in the Mediterranean with trade both domestically and internationally.



Even today it is still the center of production, processing and marketing of marbles in our country, to produce fertilizers, with the largest fertilizer industry in Greece, to produce and export -mainly in Europe- agricultural products (grapes and asparagus) and to be the most important tourist destination east of Thessaloniki, with about 500,000 visitors from Greece and abroad.

Kavala is a place that nature has endowed with rare beauty, with a rich history, glorious past and many attractions and monuments worth visiting. In Kavala, the surrounding area and Thassos, there are endless kilometres of coastline with clear blue waters and white sand that will surely impress even the most demanding visitor.

Tourism in Kavala

The Prefecture of Kavala is a popular tourist destination for Greeks and foreigners, mainly Balkans, Russians, and Turks, throughout the year) resulting in a continuous upward trend of visitors exceeding 1.5 million per year.

Perched at the foot of Mount Symbol, Kavala, like a balcony in the Aegean, opens its arms, ready to receive you and introduce you to its secrets. To travel you from antiquity to the present, to tell you stories from the past, when he met Philip II, the Apostle of the Nations Paul and the Governor (ruler) of Egypt Mehmet Ali, to take you by the hand and lift you up in the narrow cobbled streets of the old town of Panagia up to the Fortress, to reveal beaches of unprecedented beauty and nearby destinations for getaways full of emotions, to entertain you at festivals and numerous cultural events throughout the year, treat fresh fish, tsipouro and kourabiedes.

Apart from the deep blue sea and the clean sandy shores, the very good hotel infrastructure, the various thermal springs, the Prefecture of Kavala is also a place of Christian and archaeological interest.

Remarkably close to Kavala is the ancient city of Philippi, on the road of the Old Egnatia Road, the most important archaeological site of Eastern Macedonia with its ancient theatre and castle. It was held there in 42 B.C. the well-known battle of Philippi between the assassins of Julius Caesar and the loyal generals of Rome Antonius and October with the supremacy of the latter.

Ancient Amphipolis, on the shores of the river Strymon and on the ancient Egnatia Road, is a reference point with the historical monument of the Lion of Amphipolis and the Macedonian tombs of great archaeological value. Another archeological site is the Byzantine Palace in the current site of Nea Peramos.

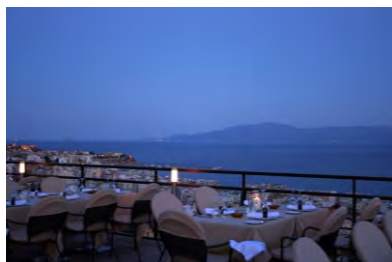

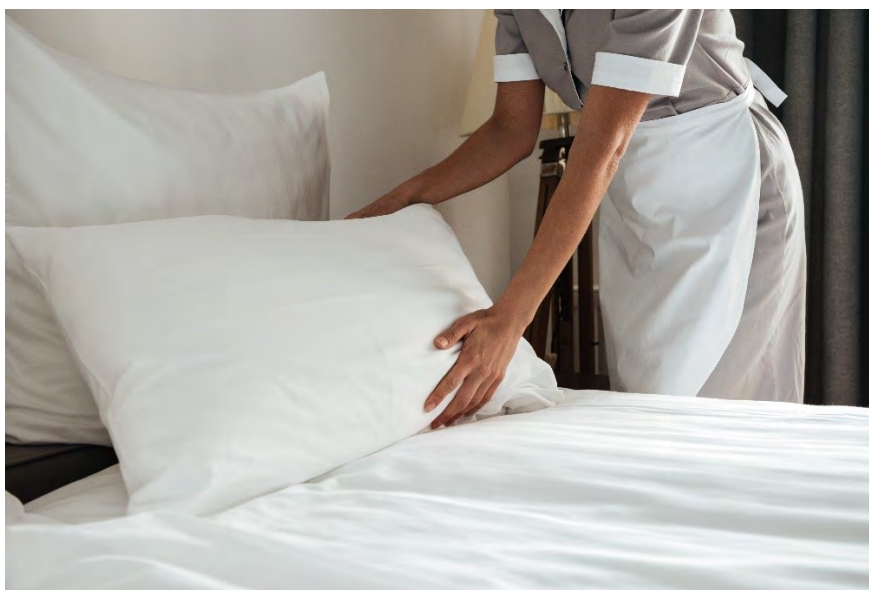

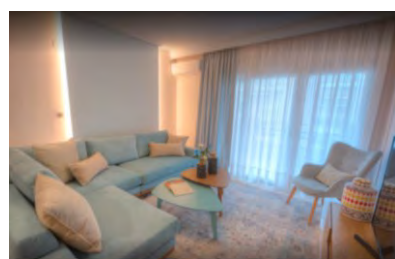

Most of the city center, as well as the

Walk in the city

Kavala favours walking. So, make the most of your mood for walking and enjoy the history, architecture and multicultural elements of the city up close. Especially if it is a sunny day, you can stop in one of the parks or gardens of the city to take a breath or even on the beach of Rapsani or Kalamitsa to enjoy a swim in their clear blue waters.

In terms of **accessibility for people with disabilities**, it is noted that the city has:

- **accessible pedestrian access** zones for wheelchair users and visually impaired people, over much of its tissue
- **parking spaces for people with disabilities** in central parts of the city
- ensuring **access to public buildings** (with wheelchair ramps, etc.)
- **audible traffic lights** at the Erithros Stavros-Dagli junction
- provisions that allow **people with disabilities to enjoy their bath** with comfort and autonomy, including the installation of SEATRAC mechanism of autonomous entry into the water on the shores of Kalamitsa and Perigiali
- modern amusement **park for people with disabilities** that operates in the area of the Municipal Sports Center of Kalamitsa "Alexandra Dimoglou"

ELEYTHERIAS SQUARE



Eleftherias Square, old Fuat Square, is the central square of Kavala. The square has the shape of a rectangle and is surrounded by the streets of **Omonia** in the north, **El. Venizelou** to the south, **Doiranis** to the east and **Ionos Dragoumi** to the west.

In the northern part of the square is the **Outdoor Municipal Shelter** which occasionally hosts speeches, performances, pre-election events, etc.

From the side of Ionos Dragoumi starts the **Municipal Train for Panagia** (see p. **Σφάλμα! Δεν έχει οριστεί σελιδοδείκτης.**), while a little further is the **Tourist Information Center** (see p. 9)

To the south you will find the **monument of Alexander the Great** as well as an EasyBike shared bicycle station.



KAPNERGATI SQUARE



Kapnergati Square, on [Kassandrou](#) and [Averof](#) Streets is the second important and central square of the city after Eleftherias Square. In Kapnergati square is the large building of the [Municipal Tobacco Warehouse](#), as well as the **monument of Kapnergati**, to which the square owes its name.

Parks & Gardens

MUNICIPAL GARDEN OF HEROES



To the left of Kyprou Street, below the City Hall, extends the Municipal Garden and extends to [El Venizelou](#) and [Averof](#). The Municipal Garden began to take shape in 1922 - 1924. Until then it had evergreen trees and wild forest vegetation and was considered a remote area from the then city center.

Apart from the monument of heroes, there is also a recreation area with a fountain and benches for the rest of the citizens after a long walk in the city, as well as a refreshment room called "Kipos" (Garden).

FALIRO MUNICIPAL PARK



Here you can start or end your walk, depending on the day and the mood.

It has rest areas, basketball court, skateboard, playgrounds, especially designed area for walking the dog. Events, concerts, a bazaar, and everything else imaginable are often organized here.

Continue to the [Amusement Park \(Louna Park\)](#) and the characteristic pier, where you can enjoy the view of the peninsula with the Fortress, the picturesque houses of Panagia and the docking boats.



Suggestions for a walk in and out of town

OLD TOWN "PANAGIA"



The walk in the Old Town of Kavala is an experience that you want to live and relive: to walk in the cobbled alleys, to gaze at the magnificent view, to read favourite readings, to taste and smell, to discover its successions a long journey of a city that, among other things, has plenty of rich stories to tell. On the rocky promontory and around its walls, the Old Town is ideal for time travel and history.

THE SURROUNDING FOREST

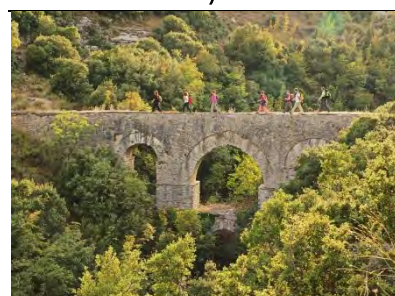

KAVALA - OLD KAVALA (THE PATH OF WATER)



This is the most important path outside the city, not only because of its aesthetic value, but mainly because of its special historical and cultural elements. The route is divided into two parts. The first half, with a length of 5 km, reaches from Kavala to "Mana tou Nero" ("Mother of Water") at the location "Tria Karagatsia". The second half with a length of 5.5 km, reaches the village of Old Kavala.

Attractions

Kavala has a rich cultural heritage and many places of historical interest. Apart from the monuments of the Ottoman Period, it is also famous for its tobacco warehouses, as tobacco production was one of the main occupations of the inhabitants of Kavala.

That is why the city is also called "Mecca of Tobacco".

Here are the main attractions, first the ones inside the old town and then the rest.

OLD TOWN ("PANAGIA")

Inhabited uninterruptedly from the 7th century BC the district of Panagia is the original historical core of the city of Kavala. Panagia, the old town of Kavala with its castle, has all those elements that will take you back in time.

There are so many attractions, neoclassical buildings, and picturesque alleys to explore. Typical examples are Mohammed Ali Square, where his statue and house, the Church of the Assumption and the Hussein Bey Mosque are located.

Each corner has its own unique identity and will take you back in time.

There **are no** paved paths in the area with "guides for the blinds". In general, **wheelchair access** to the streets and alleys of "Panagia" is **difficult**, but not impossible.

BEACH WALL



Opposite the parking lot of the Kavala Customs, 65302 Kavala



The strong walls of the Thassian colony were probably built at the beginning of the 7th century BC. Today it is a great place for walking, cycling and rest. There is also an automatic shared bicycle disposal system at the site.

On the route there is **paving with a "guides for blinds"**. The route is **wheelchair friendly**.

5TH HIGHT SCHOOL OF KAVALA

The 5th High School of Kavala is a typical Ottoman building of the city, which was built between 1902 and 1908 by the Turkish tobacconist Patsajik, as a residence.

Hundreds of Kavala's residents were imprisoned and tortured in the

basements of the building during the occupation.



IMARET

Walking on Theodorou Poulidou Street, one encounters Imaret. A huge edifice built in 1817 by Mehmet Ali Pasha as a place for Islamic teaching.

Born in Kavala in 1769, he occupied the office of Governor (regent) of Egypt in 1805 and never forgot his beloved birthplace. Thus, he built in one of the most beautiful areas of the city a seminary, Imaret, with an area of 4,500 sq.m.

Today, this masterpiece of Islamic architecture functions as a luxury hotel.

Mehmet Ali's house was built in 1720 and is still in exceptionally good condition. The location of the house is such that it has a panoramic view from all sides.

Next to the house of Mehmet Ali is placed his bronze statue, work of the sculptor Demitriadis, which was a gift of the Greeks of Alexandria to the people of Kavala.

The Holy Church of the Dormition of the Virgin Mary (Koimiseos tis Theotokou) is located in the historic district of Panagia, within the walls of the peninsula, where half of the inhabitants and families that lived during the Turkish occupation were Greek Orthodox Christians. In this small district, those Greeks who lived during the times of slavery had the mind of the Christian faith so deep that it operated since then a monastery in the same area where the church is built today, in which he even consecrated, near his mother, Saint Philotheos Kavaliotis.

The "area of the lighthouse", as always mentioned by the locals, is one of the most enchanting areas of Panagia and one dares to hide good secrets of the past.

You can see the sea panoramically, enjoy the sunset and if the sky is clear, you can see in the background the island of Thassos, in the west Mount Athos and in the east the beaches of Keramoti.

The route to the lighthouse is **wheelchair friendly**.

Today in the courtyard there is an open-air theater for music, theater, dance and events of all kinds. It has a refreshment room and a shop for information and souvenirs.

These imposing arches are perhaps one of the famous and impressive sights in Kavala. Initially, they were part of a system, the Medieval Aqueduct, which carried water from Mount Symbol to the rock of Panagia in the Old Town. It is one of the great public works executed by Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent with the vizier of Ibrahim Pasha. Having a total length of 6.4 km, the aqueduct was built with a significant slope due to the location. It survives to this day, about half a millennium later, intact and in very good condition.

The wonderful relationship of the national Apostle Paul with Europe and its

peoples, begins with the divine vision "going in Macedonia help me" (Proverbs 16: 9). He is called to Macedonia to teach the word of Christ to the Europeans.

The first European soils that Apostle Paul trampled on in 49 AD, are in the city of ancient Naples, as Kavala was then known, already an important port and commercial center.

In fact, Kavala is not accidentally called Christoupolis for 600 years, before it got its current name.

At the place where he landed, there is today the Church of Agios Nikolaos, in the courtyard of which the modern inhabitants of Kavala built the brilliant mosaic monument 'Step of St. Paul', work of the painter Vlasios Tsotsonis and the mosaicist Pino Pastorutti to honor fact.

Then the Apostle walked on the [ancient Egnatia Road](#) that survives to this day and crossed the 12 kilometers to the city of Philippi, "that is the first city of Macedonia colony" (Pr. 16, 12), where he founded the first Church in Europe. and baptized the first European Christian, the pious [Lydia](#).

He was accompanied by the evangelist Luke, the apostle Timothy and Saint Silas, in whose honor the homonymous [Holy Monastery of the Apostle Silas](#) operates today in Kavala.

MANSION VIX (CITY HALL B')

It belonged to the German baron Adolf De Zolnai Vix. Architecturally, the building has many features in common with the current town hall building (10 Kyprou Street).

Today, it belongs to the Municipality of Kavala and houses some of its services.

CITY HALL

It was built around 1985 by the Hungarian tobaccoist Baron Pierre Herzog and is a miniature of a Hungarian tower.

It is probably the most impressive building in the city, with a unique and completely "foreign" architectural line in Kavala.

Since 1937, the Municipality of Kavala is housed here.



MANSION TOKOU (OLD CITY HALL)

It was built in 1879 as the residence of the tobacco merchant Dimitrios Tokos. It is a building of Ottoman neoclassicism and baroque and at the same time preserves some elements of the local tradition. Today it has been restored with great sensitivity and houses the 12th Ephorate of Byzantine Antiquities of the Ministry of Culture.

PORT OF SLAUGHTERHOUSES



In the "back port" of the city, in the neighbourhood of Slaughterhouses, the sea view is accompanied by appetizers in the taverns of the area. And just when you thought the city was over, you see another picturesque harbor. The port in the old "Slaughterhouses" has everything you ask for. Taverns with fresh fish and meat, cafes, beautiful views and quiet away from the noise of the city.

PORT / COASTAL ROAD



This port has played a key role in the evolution and development of the city from antiquity until today. It was founded by the Thasians at the end of the 7th century BC and kept open the roads to the Aegean and the coasts of Central Asia.

From 2002 the commercial traffic was transferred to the port of N. Karvali "Filippos B", so now the port serves the passenger traffic to and from Thassos, Lemnos, Mytilene and Samothrace, tourism, fishing fleet and water sports.

The heart of the city beats today on the coastal road that leads to the port. Everything you need for beach walks among palm trees, squares, and bars. Take it on foot or using public bicycles.

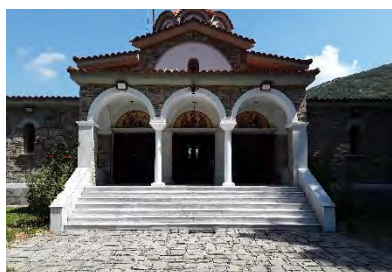
Religious places

In many parts of the area the visitor can meet buildings and monuments of worship of different doctrines and religions, which reveal the multicultural heritage of the area over the centuries.

The heritage of Greek Orthodoxy is an integral part of the national identity and is a pole of attraction for visitors. The first European church was founded in [Philippi](#) in 49 AD by Apostle Paul and the first European Christian was baptized Saint Lydia, Philippia.

There are many early Christian monasteries and churches that are preserved, with their remarkable illustration, their mosaics, their frescoes, and their rare icons.

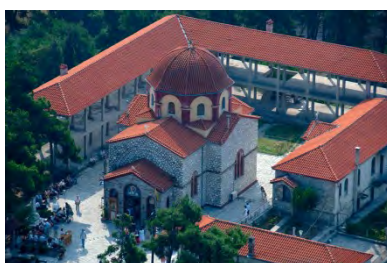


It is located on the river Zygaktis, west of ancient Philippi, where according to the narration of the Evangelist Luke (Acts chap. 11), Apostle Paul baptized the first Greek and European Christian, Lydia of Filippi.

Every year, on the day of the memory of Isapostle Saint Lydia of Philippi on May 20, after the end of the festive Hierarchical Divine Liturgy, clergy and people with His Eminence the Metropolitan of Philippi of Neapolis and Thassos are present at the river Zigakti where adult Baptism is performed. The moments are unique and extremely moving.

According to the Acts of the Apostles, Apostle Paul was imprisoned in Philippi when he healed a child who had a divinatorial spirit. Today above the market of Philippi there is the propylon of the great Early Christian Church. A narrow corridor leads to the crypt of the Church in a small dark building with two spaces covered by arches. This building is believed to have been **the prison of Apostle Paul**.

It celebrates on July 30.

Just three kilometers outside Kavala, following the national road Kavala-Thessaloniki, exactly where it joins the surviving sections of the old famous [Egnatia Road](#) is the Holy Monastery of Saint Apostle Silas.

It is a men's monastery and belongs administratively to the metropolis of Kavala.

From the monastery, the view of Kavala is wonderful. In front of it are the beautiful beaches with their natural harbors. Deep in the bay are the well-known oil wells. And beyond, the pearl of the northern Helladic islands, Thassos.

The city itself, literally perched on the rocks and ravines that form as the mountains descend almost abruptly into the sea, almost completely justifies the reflection of all these experts who attributed the name of the city to the peculiarity of the land.

This picturesque area, surrounded by a wonderful rich green, was not chosen at random for the construction of the monastery. During the tradition, the Apostle Paul and his associates Silas, Timothy and Luke sat down to rest at this point.

This is also mentioned by the marble column that is today in front and a little to the left of the Katholikon of the monastery:

“IN ANCIENT TRADITION, THE HOLY APOSTLES PAUL AND SILAS RESTED HERE DURING THEIR FIRST MISSIONAL VISIT TO PHILIP.”

The Church of Saint Georgios of Kavala is in the homonymous area in the city center.

There was a mosque where a committee placed a cross and decided to establish it as a Holy Temple in the name of St. George and to place icons and relics brought from the unforgettable homelands.

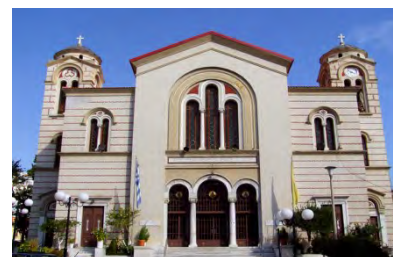
In 1983 the church and the chapel of Saint Marina were demolished (its image was transferred to the left aisle of the current church) and in 1985 the new building is ready, which is equipped with all the necessary furniture and sacred utensils for its operation.

In 2004 the Hagiography on the wall begins.

The church is a three-aisled basilica with a dome.

The Cathedral of St. Paul the Apostle was founded to honor and extol the fact that in this city - then Naples, subsequently Christoupolis and today Kavala - arrived for the first time in Greece, as well as in Europe in general, Apostle of the Nations Paul.

The construction of the Holy Temple began with a group of devout Christians in the early 1900s. Finally, the foundation stone was laid in 1905 by the Metropolitan of Xanthi Ioakeim Sgouros, after the Greek Community had previously sought the consent of the Turkish Administration, as the city was still under Turkish occupation as the city was still under Turkish occupation.

AKODISMA

ANCIENT THEATRE



The ancient theatre of Philippi is a remarkable and important monument. It is located at the foot of the citadel hill and rests on the eastern wall of the city of Philippi. Although it has undergone many changes over the centuries and some interventions to be able to host the Philippi Festival, it retains many of its elements.

ANCIENT CITY

Opposite the ancient theatre of Philippi are the ruins of the ancient city. The city got its name in 356 BC. by the father of Alexander the Great, Philip II.

The archaeological site of Philippi can offer the visitor a mixed tour, since the excavations have brought to light ruins from the Hellenistic,

Roman, Byzantine, and Early Christian periods. The octagon, the Roman market, the early Christian royal sections of the city walls, are the best known of these.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM



The Archaeological Museum of Philippi is located on the outskirts of the archaeological site and has two sections of exhibition spaces for the permanent presentation of the findings from the excavations of the ancient city:

Section A': Occupies the entire ground floor. This section presents archaeological (inscriptions, sculptures, pottery, coins, jewellery), historical and supervisory material of the city of Philippi and its area from prehistoric times to the end of Roman antiquity.

Section B': Occupies the floor of the building. It presents the Christian city (inscriptions, architectural members, mosaics, vases, coins) from the early Christian years of prosperity to its shrinkage in the 7th AD. century and until its final desolation after the Turkish conquest at the end of the 14th century.

People with disabilities have access to the Museum premises.



Nestos river

Escape to nature



Nestos is one of the five largest and most important rivers in Greece. It originates from Mount Rila in Bulgaria and flows into the Thracian Sea.

It is located about 28 km east of Kavala and is the natural border of Macedonia and Thrace. The flow of the river from the Greek-Bulgarian border to its estuary, has created several ecosystems that host many plants and animals, many of which are rare or endangered.

The visitor can walk the paths of Nestos on foot or from the special facilities by bicycle enjoying, can do rafting, canoe-cayak, etc.

Visit the village of Toxotes (40 km) from where the excursions start and live a unique experience in nature.

The picturesque Palio (Old), Kalamitsa with the youth beach bars, Iraklitsa, Peramos and Batis with the green scenery and the beautiful restaurants, and of course the spectacular Ammolofoi (Dunes) with the crystal-clear waters and the light sandy beach are the necessary stops on the Kavala coastline.

RAPSANI

Inside the city



“Child of the city” almost in the center, near the park of Faliro, for those who can not leave the city.

It has a length of 3 km and combines fine sand with crystal clear waters creating the illusion that the visitor is on an exotic beach!

It has been awarded the **Blue Flag** for its clear waters.

The beach is divided into three parts with the presence of rocks and their names starting from the east to the west are: first Ammolofoi (Sand Dunes), second Ammolofoi (Sand Dunes) and third Ammolofoi (Sand Dunes).

It has an organized beach with beach bars, sunbeds, umbrellas, and free parking.

Admission to all beaches is free.

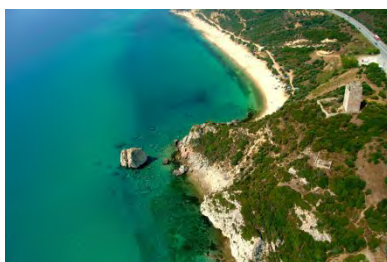

The Tower of Apollonia is located on the south side of the old National Road Thessaloniki - Kavala, between the mouth of the river Strymon and the gulf of the Free. It probably got its name from the misjudgement of the time about the exact location of the ancient city of Apollonia. The building dates back to the 14th century and had a military purpose. It was built to control the movements throughout the sea area, from Kavala (then Christoupoli) to Mount Athos.

If you follow the dirt road near the tower, you will end up with a beach that offers endless blue, calm and serenity.

It does not have infrastructure / facilities for people with disabilities.



OFRYNIOU BEACH

58 km west



In the clear blue waters of Ofryniou beach (Tuzla) you will find a vast beach with white sand and colorful pebbles, umbrellas. Fish taverns and grills for tsipouro or ouzo at noon and for the evening come to enjoy the night life. There are hotels, rooms to let, apartments, supermarkets, lots of shops and you can find everything.


Also, from the beach start two paths for mountaineering in Paggaio.

Finally, the beaches of Kariani and Akropotamos are of unique beauty and every summer they are flooded with vacationers and visitors.

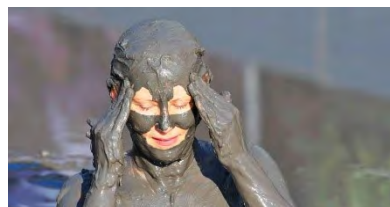
